EXAMPLE PROJECTS

CONSERVATION: Southern Ground Hornbill

The poisoning of wildlife is increasing in South Africa and vulnerable species like the Southern Ground Hornbill are suffering unsustainable losses. Our grant of \$1500 helped fund a workshop to explore solutions to the problem.



EDUCATION: Creating community awareness

Lake Ol' bolossat is an important bird area in Kenva's Central Province. We provided \$860 to support local guide George Ndung'u to teach schoolchildren and their families the importance of the wetland habitat to their livelihoods.



HABITAT: Madagascar's spiny forest

The spiny forests of Madagascar have unparalleled levels of diversity and endemism but suffer the fastest rates of forest loss in the country. ABC funds supported a major survey of the birds and reptiles in the habitat.
